Here is our topic web for Summer terms 1 and 2. The children have helped come up with ideas for their homework this time based on our topics this term.

Please can:

Year 2 to do at least 5 pieces

Year 1 to do at least 4 pieces

Reception to do 2 pieces

I will also have some maths worksheets which will link to maths that the children can take home weekly. They just have to help themselves to a sheet.

Each child has a homework book, which homework can be done in. Extra team points will be awarded this time for presentation, correct punctuation, spellings and grammar. Please encourage them to try their best and think about what they are making.

1. Go on a walk and photograph and identify wild flowers	6tps
2. Play maths games at home and bring in a favourite maths game to school.	5tps
3. Make a new version of snakes and ladders based on the Amazon Rainforest	6tps
4. Grow and look after your bean and complete your bean diary.	6tps
5. Create your own small tin forest.	6tps
6. Make a poster or leaflet about how to look after plants	6tps
7. Do an observational drawing of wild flowers or garden flowers using pencil, watercolours or another media of choice.	6tps
8. Create a poem about the Rainforest	5tps
9. Write a prayer about our value of thankfulness.	5tps
10. Gather pebbles and paint rainforest animal patterns on them.	5tps
11. Whilst outside, close your eyes and imagine that you are standing in the middle of a rainforest or a jungle. Write or draw to show what you imagine that you will hear, see, smell and feel.	6tps
Games and programmes to help with reading: Alphablocks and BBC Bitesize KS1 have lots of English games, phonics play and letters and sounds websites are all good. BBC Bitesize KS1 also has lots of maths and science games which can reinforce learning at school. Mathletics homework will continue to be set weekly and consolidates the previous week's lessons. We are able to monitor who does homework so if you don't have access to a computer then this can be done at school. All pieces completed will give you 5tps
