WOOLTASTIC!

1. Take part in the RSPB Big Garden Birdwatch. <https://www.rspb.org.uk/get-involved/activities/birdwatch/> 6tps
2. Draw a map of where you live and label places that are special to you. 5tps
3. Make something out of wool. You could make a collage or try knitting or crochet. 10 tps
4. Draw a picture of yourself in your favourite outfit. Label the fabric each item of clothing is made from and where it comes from. 6tps
5. Find out about the life cycle of a sheep and choose how you record the information you find out. 5tps
6. Go on a walk with your family. What signs can you see or hear that might be a sign of Spring coming? Choose how you record this - you could take photos, write about what you saw and heard or draw a picture. 6 tps
7. Find a recipe, work out how much it would cost to buy the ingredients and which coins and/or notes you would need to pay for it all. Is there only one answer? (5pts) You could make the recipe and take photos. (5tps)
8. Find a traditional tale from another country. Read then write a book review describing what you like and don't like about the story. 6tps
9. Build a house for a character in a fairy tale and explain why you have chosen the materials. 10 tps
10. Practise and re-tell one of your favourite fairy tales, using actions. You could either re-tell it to the class or ask someone at home to video your performance and email it to: admin@christchurch-chal.gloucs.sch.uk 5 tps

Games and programmes to help with reading: Alphablocks and BBC Bitesize KS1 has lots of English games, phonics play and letters and sounds websites are all good.
BBC Bitesize KS1 also has lots of maths and science games which can reinforce learning at school.

Year 2 - Don't forget to keep practising your times tables rockstars (if you have lost your log-in details, Mrs Clarke has a copy in the classroom)

Remember to bring in homework books each Monday so we can share the work and add spellings and maths sheets, which will help develop recall of number and multiplication fact.

The children can choose the activities they wish to complete from the topic web and we hope that between now and Christmas the children will complete the following number of pieces:

- Year 2 - 5 pieces or more
- Year 1 - 4 pieces or more
