Here is Autumn 1 and 2 terms topic web. Please note:

- Year 2 to do at least 5 pieces
- Year 1 to do at least 4 pieces

100 team points will be given to anyone who does all the homework set and trophy for completing it!

Each child has a homework book, please use this for the homework. Extra team points will be awarded for presentation, correct punctuation, spellings and grammar. Please encourage them to try their best and think about what they are making.

1. Create a family tree poster. 6tps

2. Can you find out 10 fun facts about dinosaurs? What was the biggest? 5tps

3. Create a world out of a shoe box for Harry and his dinosaurs to visit. 6tps

4. Play maths games with your family, snakes and ladders, cards and junior monopoly are all good ways to have fun with maths. Take a photo and bring it in to talk about what you played. 6tps

5. Create a collage of all your favourite things to talk about in class. 4tps

6. Be an explorer, go into your garden and dig a pit to see what you can find, record your findings. Good luck looking for fossils. 10tps

7. What could you buy or do if you had £10? Make a poster or leaflet of what you did or would wish to buy. List the prices for everything. 6tps

8. Can you create a list of verbs and nouns that you find in your reading books? 6tps

9. We are finding out about what you and your parents did after school, but what about your Grandparents/ older family friend? Write them a letter or ask them to visit to find out about what they did after school. Then write about what you found out. 10 tps

10. We are creating fabric faces and have done our own self- portrait. Can you paint someone else portrait that are in your family? (Animals are included). 10 tps

Other things which you could do to find out about our topic is to visit to the Natural History Museum or if that's a bit far Stratford Park Museum has a fantastic room full of fossils and activities that were done in the past.

Games and programmes to help with reading: Alphablocks and BBC Bitesize KS1 has lots of English games, phonics play and letters and sounds websites are all good. BBC Bitesize KS1 also has lots of maths and science games which can reinforce learning at school.

Mathletics homework will continue to be set weekly and will consolidate the previous week's lessons. We are able to monitor who does homework so if you don't have access to a computer then this can be done at school. All pieces completed will give you 5tps

All homework books to be brought in on Thursday so we can share the work and add some maths games, which will help develop their multiplication knowledge.
